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4. FIRST AID MEASURES (continued)

- After inhalation : Assure fresh air breathing. Obtain medical attention if breathing difficulty persists.
- After contact with skin : Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse. Seek medical attention if irritation develops.
- After contact with eyes : Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Seek medical attention if irritation develops.
- After ingestion : DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Seek medical attention immediately.
- Other Information : If there is any suspicion of aspiration into the lungs either directly or as a result of vomiting, obtain medical advice.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

- Suitable extinguishing media : Dry chemical. Water fog. Foam. Carbon dioxide. Sand.
- Extinguishing media which shall not be used : Do not use a heavy water stream.
- Special exposure hazards
 - Surrounding fires : Use water spray or fog for cooling exposed containers.
 - Combustion products/ resulting gases : Under fire conditions, hazardous fumes will be present.
- Special protective equipment for fire-fighters : Fire-fighters should use standard protective equipment and in enclosed spaces, self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

- Personal precautions : Keep public away from danger area. Wear recommended personal protective equipment. Equip cleanup crew with proper protection.
- Environmental precautions : Prevent entry to sewers and public waters.
- Cleaning methods : Clean up any spills as soon as possible, using an absorbent material to collect it. Collect spills and put it into appropriated container. Use suitable disposal containers. Recover the cleaning water for disposal. Spill area may be slippery.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

- General : No naked lights. No smoking. Keep away from sources of ignition.
- Precautions in handling and storage : Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety procedures.
- Storage : Keep container closed when not in use. Keep at temperature not exceeding 45°C. Keep only in the original container in a cool, well ventilated place.
- Handling : Wash hands and other exposed areas with mild soap and water before eat, drink or smoke and when leaving work.
